

Eligible applicants will be contacted to either register or arrange an interview & assessment, which corresponds with the ADEK and AGS requirements. Based on specific criteria determined by AGS administration, some students will require an entrance assessment, which will cost 50 AED, paid by the applicant. All applicants who have been approved to register must pay 20% at the time of registration to reserve their seat. Due to the high number of applications received and seat availability, we will <u>only</u> contact those applicants who are selected to either register or sit for an Interview and Assessment based on seats available.
